Our OSHC service is managed by Catherine McAuley School in consultation with the Management Committee which comprises of representatives from both Playford Primary and Catherine McAuley schools and parent representatives.

The service has dedicated educators who have either formal qualifications in childcare or teaching or less formal training in the childcare field. As a team we are committed to the continual enhancement and improvement of our knowledge through ongoing professional development and training.

The future of Playford McAuley OSHC is to continue quality care for children, continually assess the services needs, upgrade/extend the service facilities so that we are able to offer care to all families of our growing school community.



## ACTIVITIES

Playford McAuley OSHC is able to access many of the Campus facilities including the playgrounds, sandpit, hardcourts and oval. This provides us with plenty of opportunities for activities within these areas.

Activities that are offered to children everyday include homework, drawing, board games, home corner/dramatic play, outdoor areas and television or DVD viewing.

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## PARENT PARTICIPATION

## HOURS OF SERVICE & MEALS

**BEFORE SCHOOL CARE.....6.30am to 8.40am**

A variety of toast, cereal, yoghurt and drinks are provided. Breakfast is served at the breakfast table where children can chat with friends.

**AFTER SCHOOL CARE .....3.00pm to 6.00pm**

Children are offered a variety of fresh fruit, sandwiches and a hot snack. Afternoon tea is served in a social environment where your child is able to chat with friends.

**VACATION CARE .....7.00am to 6.00pm**

As above breakfast items are available for your child. Afternoon tea is normally prepared by the children and shared in a social atmosphere.

## FEES

Child Care Subsidy is available to families which means a percentage of your fee will be paid by the FAO.

All this requires is for you to provide us with your Centrelink CRN and inform Centrelink through the MyGov app that your child will be attending our service.
